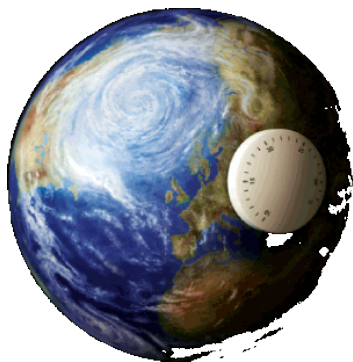

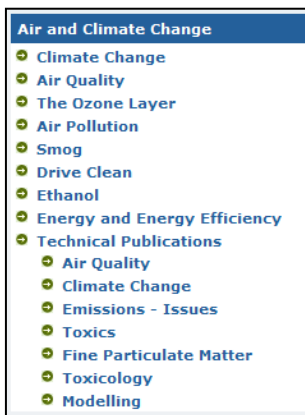

United Nations Climate Change Conference in Bali

Representatives of over 180 countries, observers from intergovernmental and nongovernmental organizations, and the media attended this conference in Bali, Indonesia. The conference culminated in the adoption of the [Bali Road Map](#), which consists of a number of forward-looking decisions that represent the various tracks that are essential to reaching a secure climate future. The Bali Road Map includes the [Bali Action Plan](#), which charts the course for a new negotiating process designed to tackle climate change, with the aim of completing this by 2009. It also includes the AWG-KP negotiations and their 2009 deadline, the launch of the Adaptation Fund, the scope and content of the Article 9 review of the Kyoto Protocol, as well as decisions on technology transfer and on reducing emissions from deforestation.

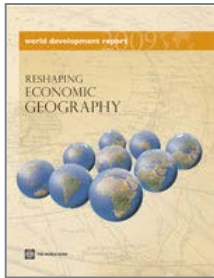

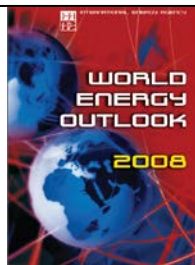
