This listing¹ of sources for educational research is designed to supplement the material in the McMillan & Schumacher text and materials mentioned in class and during the library workshop. The list is not complete, so please let me know if you identify important reference materials that are not listed here. Library of Congress numbers are given in square brackets where possible: most shelved in the Reference section of the Education Library. (APA style has not been used in all items in this list.)

Avoid using electronic searches in the early stages of exploring research in an area. It's more useful to read the secondary sources so that you get a feel for research in the area as well as a sense of who the principal actors are. I can help you identify potentially useful secondary sources or suggest colleagues who have specialized knowledge.

Vital Secondary Sources and Acronyms

The American Educational Research Association (**AERA**) publishes two important review journals:

1. *Review of Research in Education*, 1973–, an **AERA** annual, shelved in reference [ref LB1028.R48]. This is frequently referred to as **RRE**. [Contents are reproduced in a duotang after the last volume]
2. *Review of Educational Research*, an **AERA** review serial, shelved by title in the bound Periodicals collection on Floor 2. Known as **RER**.

AERA also publishes *Educational Researcher* (**ER**), a monthly with excellent commentary on research.

The National Society for the Study of Education (**NSSE**) in the USA publishes two-part yearbooks (1929–) that are excellent reviews. They may be searched on line: <http://www.uic.edu/educ/nsse> or in the stacks [LB5 N27].

Indexes, Bibliographies, and Abstracts

Indexes are available online through the Queen's Library website, as are many journals. For access from your home,

Go to the Queen's Library page at <http://library.queensu.ca/> and select **Connect from Off Campus**.

A vital resource for library use is the small document prepared by the Education Librarians: "**Find a Journal Article**."

Preliminary strategies for library searching should involve use of the secondary sources. Electronic databases are useful only when you have an idea of the scope and terrain of the field of interest.

ERIC continues to be the principal educational research index. Recently, it has suffered a hiatus, but it is being restored. Note that about 95% of fulltext ERIC documents, 1993 onwards, are available online.

Education Research Complete and the **Professional Development Collection** via EBSCOhost and **Education Full Text** via WilsonWeb have full text as well as indexing. ERC indexes 1,730 journals and includes the full text of 800 journals, 67 books, and many conference papers. PDC indexes about 720 journals of which 555 are available in full text. EFT has full text for 314 of its 555 journals and yearbooks.

Other databases for more advanced searching are *PsycINFO*, *ProQuest Dissertations and Theses*, *PsycARTICLES (full text)*, *Australian Education Index*, and *Database on English Language Teaching for Australasia*. These are all available via the Queen's Library Home Page --> Find Journal Articles.

The former Canadian Education Index is available via the Queen's Library as CBCA Education (Canadian Business and Current Affairs)

CanGuide, online database of K-12 Canadian curriculum guidelines, is at:

<http://www.oise.utoronto.ca/canguide/> but note that it is not current for all provinces. Try provincial government websites.

There are *lots* of other databases: click on **Find Journal Articles & More** and use the alphabetic listing and explore.

Queen's subscribes to over 27,000 on-line journals in all disciplines. The **Electronic Journals & Newspapers** database on the Library homepage provides a full listing; and all on-line journals are listed in the Queen's Library Catalogue (QCAT).

Tip: **Global Books in Print** is a great way to get information you have mislaid about a book reference!

For materials not available at Queen's, ask a research librarian about interlibrary loan through RACER.
