Indexes 650 journals in the field of education, with full text included for 251 of these titles. Coverage focuses on information in the field of education of interest to both educational researchers and teachers.

[Canadian Education \(CBCA\)](#) (via: ProQuest)

CBCA Education indexes over 260 education-related journals and newsletters, and includes abstracts and fulltext articles for a selection of these titles. The Canadian content in the database makes this the database of choice for periodical information on Canadian education

[ERIC Database](#)  (via: Scholars Portal Search)

Produced by Educational Resources Information Center , ERIC is the largest education database in the world. Has 2 separate indexes: Current Index to Journals in Education (CIJE) and Resources in Education (RIE). CIJE has 900 journals. RIE indexes unpublished resources such as conference papers and exemplary curriculum resources.
