Awarded by: The Ontario Arts Council and the Canadian Bookseller's Association, with the help of juries of children from Ontario public schools

This prize honours authors and illustrators who demonstrate artistic excellence in Canadian children's literature. Winning books are selected by juries of children in Ontario (one year from a school in Toronto and the next from a school outside Toronto). Students in grade 4 award the \$5,000 children's picture book
