## How to Find Books and Multimedia

<p><b>Ministry of Education documents</b></p> <p><b>Browsing Tip:</b> All M of E documents are on Floor 2. Best to know the call number for these, so go with a keyword search!</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• select <b>Education Library</b> as your <b>Quick Limit</b></li> <li>• select <b>Keyword</b> as your <b>Search by</b> method</li> </ul> <p>Example:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">curriculum and Ontario and health and 8 curriculum and Ontario and health and 11</p>
<p><b>Reference Books</b></p> <p><b>Browsing Tip:</b> Use your Library of Congress call number knowledge or guide. The usual call number area for health is R – RA and for physical education is GV.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A small collection that is easily browsed.</li> </ul> <p>A keyword search limited to the Education Library will lead you to a browsing area:</p> <p>The resources in the health and physical education section of our reference collection include health and game encyclopedias</p>

<p><b>Textbooks</b></p> <p><b>Browsing Tip:</b> If you do not have a specific title in mind, browse in the LC call number range for your discipline.</p> <p>R - RA for Health GV for Physical Education</p>	<p>The Ministry of Education currently has NO textbooks approved for teaching Health &amp; Physical Education for K-8. We are now adding music and art textbooks to this collection even when the books are not listed on the Trillium List. <p><b>Lesson Ideas</b></p> <p>Browsing Tip: Look for lesson ideas in OCUP units, in teacher idea books from publishers (for ex. Scholastic), in video guides, &amp; on the web.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• select <b>Education Library</b> as your <b>Quick Limit</b></li> <li>• select <b>Keyword</b> as your <b>Search by</b> method</li> <li>• usually combine (<b>lesson or teaching</b>) and your <b>keyword</b></li> </ul> <p>Example:</p> <p>Teaching health: (lesson? or teaching) and nutrition and elementary Teaching phys ed: (lesson? or teaching) and volleyball</p> <p>For Ont. Curriculum Unit Planner units (OCUP) try: "ontario curriculum centre" and health? <p><b>K-12 Non-fiction</b></p> <p>Browsing Tip: Use the LC call number guide to browse by subject.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• select <b>Education Library</b> as your <b>Quick Limit</b></li> <li>• select <b>Keyword</b> as your <b>Search by</b> method</li> <li>• combine <b>juvenile and</b> your <b>keyword</b></li> </ul> <p>Example:</p> <p>On a topic in health: body? and juvenile On a topic in physical education: hockey and juvenile</p>
<p><b>K-12 Fiction</b></p> <p>Browsing Tip: PR – British fiction PS3000s – U.S. fiction PS8000s – Canadian fiction</p>	<p>Use a subject guide to children's literature to find specific titles.</p> <p><i>A to Zoo</i> is our favorite print guide of this type. (We keep it at the Reference Desk at Z1037 .L715 2001)</p> <p>Online subject guides include: <i>NoveList</i> or the <i>Children's Literature Comprehensive Database</i>. Access via Research Tools &gt;&gt; Article Indexes &gt;&gt; By Subject &gt;&gt; Education &gt;&gt; DB Related to Children's Literature</p>
<p><b>Multimedia</b></p> <p>Browsing Tip: There are 7 mini-collections: Videos &amp; DVDs Kits Big Books Posters Audiocassettes Audiobooks CDs (Music)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• select <b>Education Library</b> as your <b>Quick Limit</b></li> <li>• select <b>Keyword</b> as your <b>Search by</b> method</li> </ul> <p>For a particular format, combine your keyword with</p> <p>video? and (smok? or tobacco) kit and body? ("study print?" or picture? or poster) and food (limit search to the Multimedia collection for this search) "compact disc" and danc?</p>

Type of Resource	Search Tip
<b>Current Periodicals</b> (new - 2005)	Browse professional teacher journals on Floor 1.  To find journal articles use an education journal index – NOT QCAT. Follow Research Tools >> Article Indexes>> Subject >> Education>>Core Databases
<b>Bound periodicals</b> (2004 and earlier)	Bound periodicals are shelved on Floor 2, alphabetically by title.
