1. Original Letter Machine & Prestige Spacesaver: cut your paper or any material that can be cut with scissors into 4 ½" strips.

Prestige Pro and XL machines: cut your paper or other material into 9" strips.

2. Put your paper under the sponge part of the wooden block.
3. Slide the block and your paper into the machine, with the wooden side of the block on top.

So you ... have wooden slide of block facing you  
sponge side of block next to the paper  
paper on the bottom

4. Move the handle of the machine from left to right, so that pressure is applied to the block.
