Note: Between **1867** and **1892**, immigration was controlled by the Department of Agriculture. From **1892** until **October 1917**, Immigration was a branch of the Department of the Interior, and then became the Department of Immigration and Colonization (**1917 to 1936**). On **December 1, 1936**, the Department of Immigration and Colonization became the Immigration Branch of the Department of Mines and Resources.
